Apr. 27	Tanner's Brook	Trail entrance on Sunnyside Lane
May 4	Lincoln Cemetery to Wheeler Farm	Lincoln Cemetery off Lexington Road
May 11	Pierce Park to Donaldson Field	Lincoln Town Offices parking lot
May 18	Mount Misery	Mount Misery parking lot on South Great Road (Route 117)
May 25	Flint's Pond Loop (this is a longer than usual walk)	Far end of DeCordova Museum parking lot
