April 2	Pierce Park	Lincoln Town Office Building – meet behind the building
April 9	Trails from School	Smith School parking lot – take Ballfield Road and take your first left into the lot
April 16	Beaver Pond	Browning Field Riding Ring – Weston Road just S. of intersection with Silver Hill Road
April 23	Adams Woods	End of Old Concord Road off of Route 126 (Concord Road)
April 30	Drumlin Farm	Drumlin's main parking lot off of Route 117 (South Great Road)
May 7	Schools to DeCordova Museum	Pool parking lot off Ballfield Road
May 14	Umbrello Land	Blue Heron Organic Farm – just east of the train tracks on Rte. 117 (South Great Road)
May 21	Wheeler Farm	Lincoln Cemetery – Lexington Road – Go in main entrance then to the left
