April 1	Codman South Fields & Forest	Codman House (Historic New England) main parking lot on north side of Codman Road
April 8	Lincoln Schools to Farm Meadow Codman Forest & Bergen-Culver	Smith School Parking Lot, Ballfield Road (the parking lot on the left as you enter)
April 15	Fairyland Pond & Brister's Hill (Concord)	Parking lot on Route 126 opposite entrance to Concord-Carlisle High School
April 22	Sandy Pond Trust Lands	Roadside pullouts at north end of Sandy Pond Road (south of Garland Road)
April 29	Farrar Pond to Dean Field	Just inside main entrance to Farrar Village, off Oxbow Road
May 6	Beaver Pond	Riding Ring at Upper Browning Field, Weston Road just south of Silver Hill Road
May 13	Adams Woods	North end of Old Concord Road
May 20	Pierce Park/Lincoln Fields	Lincoln Town Offices, 16 Lincoln Road
