Entertainment License

REGULATIONS

No entertainment – including but not limited to those types listed below – shall be offered, conducted, or otherwise provided by any establishment licensed under MGL C138 or C140 without first obtaining an entertainment license from the Board of Selectmen. Sunday entertainment must be specifically requested and addressed in the permitting process. These regulations are intended to allow the Board of Selectmen to determine the appropriate parameters to limit impacts to the neighbors of the establishment, and to the community by the establishment and the entertainment provided therein.

EL1 – Jukebox, Radio, TV, Billiards, Automatic Amusement Devices

EL2 – Dancing by Patrons

EL3 - Live Performers(including Dancers, Singers, DJ's and Karaoke and other forms of live performance) , Live/Recorded Music, Amplification System

Entertainment License Application:

1. All applicants shall submit to the Board the Entertainment License Application prior to providing said entertainment.
2. As part of the application process, applicants must sign a certification of payment of state taxes pursuant to MGL, C62c, s57 and Section 16 of the General Bylaws of the Town of Lincoln.
3. Applicants must submit all forms and additional documentation to the Office of the Board of Selectmen along with the annual fee of \$25.00. in the form of a certified check in the amount of made payable to The Town of Lincoln.
4. Licenses may be issued by the Board with conditions as is determined appropriate and necessary.
5. The License shall be valid for the calendar year in which it is issued, and shall expire on Dec 31 of the year issued.

Compliance with State and Local Laws and Regulations:

1. All licensees must conform to the provisions of any relevant state or local laws, permits, codes or other requirements.
2. The Board of Selectmen reserves the right to establish further limitations or modifications to the conditions of the license with prior notice to the license holder.
3. A licensee who fails to maintain the premises, implements or facilities, or who fails to conduct the business in a proper manner as required shall have the license revoked.

Revocation of License:

1. If, in the opinion of the Board, a license holder ceases to be engaged in the business it is licensed to pursue, or fails to maintain on the premises the implements of facilities required by law, it shall have its license revoked immediately.
2. If any licensee conducts the licensed business in an improper manner, the Board may, after notice to the license holder and with reasonable opportunity for a hearing, suspend or revoke the license upon satisfactory proof thereof.
