**Comprehensive Long Range Plan Committee (CLRPC)**

**Public Forum**

**Tuesday, June 19, 2007 at 7:00 PM in Bemis Hall**

The CLRPC wants to hear from you. In the first of several public forums to be held, the CLRPC is asking you to come hear about their work and take this opportunity to express your thoughts on the important issues facing the Town of Lincoln. The CLRPC subcommittees will be explaining what their top issues are and participants will have an opportunity to play an interactive role in prioritizing or adding to the list of issues. So come out and tell us what you think.

The CLRPC is made up of members of the community who have volunteered their time to help prepare a long range plan for the Town of Lincoln. Why do we need a long range plan? A Comprehensive Long Range Plan will provide guidance, coordination, and accountability to future decision makers in the town so that major decisions are not made in a vacuum.

The CLRPC has been meeting for several months developing the process for creation of the long range plan and developing a process where the subcommittees are looking at the many issues the Town is facing. The meeting on the June 19<sup>th</sup> will be a public forum whereby you will have an opportunity to hear what the subcommittees have been working on and help the subcommittees prioritize these issues. The CLRPC is broken out into five subcommittees:

The subcommittees are charged with developing the required elements of the long range plan. The CLRPC is charged with putting together a comprehensive implementation plan that incorporates and integrates the various proposals of the subcommittees.

It is anticipated that the process will take approximately 16 months to complete with a target date of the State Of The Town (SOTT) Meeting in the Fall of 2008. During this period the CLRPC will be engaging a consultant to help with the process, holding several meetings to explain to the public the ideas and solutions that come up in the plan and finally presentation of the final plan itself for a vote at the 2008 SOTT.
