## **Lincoln Community Invited To Attend Regularly Schedule Campus Master Planning Committee Meetings**

The Lincoln Campus Master Planning Committee (CMPC), composed of three At-Large representatives as well as representatives from the Lincoln Public Schools, Town Selectmen, Conservation Committee, Council of Aging, Parks & Recreation, the Planning Board, and Roadway and Traffic, is charged with studying the basic infrastructure and physical layout of the Ballfield Road campus and informing the planning for the contemplated school building and community center projects.
