GENERAL PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. All system construction or repairs shall be made in accordance to:
 - (a) Plans approved in writing by the Board of Health,
 - (b) Title 5 of the State Environmental Code, 310 CMR 15.000, *Standard Requirements for the Siting, Construction, Inspection, Upgrade and Expansion of On-site Sewage Treatment and Disposal Systems and for the Transport and Disposal of Septage*,
 - (c) The most recent version of the Lincoln Board of Health Regulation.
2. Proposed construction or repair shall not begin until after the Board of Health issues a Disposal System Construction Permit, except in the following circumstances:
 - (a) Emergency repairs as per 310 CMR 15.353, or
 - (b) Installation of riser on system component during inspection, provided that no other components are replaced.
3. System shall be constructed or repaired by a person or firm with a valid Disposal System Installer's Permit on file with the Board. It is the installer's responsibility to schedule inspections with the office of the Board of Health.
4. Completed system shall not be placed into service and building that uses system shall not be occupied until:
 - (a) Installer submits an "as built" plan to the Board of Health, and
 - (b) Board of Health issues a Certificate of Compliance to the property owner.
5. The Board of Health may impose additional conditions after reviewing this application and may, at any stage of construction, require necessary modifications if conditions are encountered that were not originally observed.
6. Permit expires three years from date of issuance.
