Vaccination Clinic Planning

January 29, 2021

- This is Tim Higgins, Lincoln's Town Administrator calling with important information about the Lincoln Public Health Team's COVID 19 vaccination clinic plans.
- **Provided that the Town is supplied vaccine by the State**, the Town will be hosting its first vaccination clinic on Thursday, February 11<sup>th</sup>, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., at the Lincoln North Office Complex, located at **55 Old Bedford Road** off Hanscom Drive and Route 2A in north Lincoln.
- Consistent with the priorities and criteria established by the State, our February 11<sup>th</sup> clinic will be available exclusively to Lincoln residents age 75 and up.
- As a result of statewide vaccine supply limitations, we will only be able to register 100 residents in the first clinic.
- A town-staffed call center will be established to facilitate the registration process. Computer access or expertise will not be necessary. Our call center staff will request customary information and simultaneously schedule appointments for the initial shot and the booster 28 days out.
- We will notify the public of the opportunity to register once we receive our supply of vaccine. Notification will be made via reverse 911 phone messaging, various e-mail networks, on electronic message boards **and the Town's website**.
- Residents who have reasonable access to vaccine through their primary care physicians, area pharmacies or other sources, are strongly urged to take advantage of these channels and not wait for the Town-sponsored clinics. It may be several weeks or even months before the supply of vaccine ~~increases~~ sufficiently to meet our needs
