- This is Lincoln Town Administrator Tim Higgins calling on behalf of the Town's Public Health Team with an update on the Town's plans for this week's local COVID vaccination clinic.
- We have accommodated all requests from our 85+ population and **are now able to register residents age 75+.**
- **If you were born in 1945 or earlier, you are invited to call our COVID vaccine call center tomorrow, Tuesday, February 9 between 10am and 4pm.**
- **We will be offering reservations for this Thursday, February 11, as well as reservations on Thursday, February 18.**
- All clinics will be held at the Lincoln North Office Complex, 55 Old Bedford Road, off Hanscom Drive and Route 2A in north Lincoln, between the hours of 10 am and 2 pm.
