What is VACA-PLAYDAYS?

Arts, Crafts, Sports, Music, Games and more...! For the sixth year, we're inviting kids Kindergarten through Fifth grade to join our vacation program. The program runs from 8:00 am - 4:00 pm and will provide kids the opportunity to get out of the house and hang out with friends in a relaxed and fun-filled environment at the LEAP building (Pod C).

"I like to think of the LEAP building like a giant ship. For the 4 days of the program, we're all on a themed cruise together. Since we don't get to go away for vacation with our families, we go with our friends on the Vaca-Playdays Cruise in our imaginations."

To jazz up the week, we will have surprise guest entertainment. Kids should bring their own lunches and come prepared with appropriate clothing for outdoor play.

This is a 2, 3 or 4 day program. Because of the small nature of this program and the intimate "family on vacation" atmosphere we try to promote, we encourage participants to attend as many days as possible. We do ask participants who will be absent due to illness or for any reason to call by 9 am.

CANCELLATIONS:

A minimum of 15 children are required to run this program. If fewer than 15 register (*by February 8 for the February Program and April 12 for the April Program*), we reserve the right to cancel the program and you will receive a full refund. Otherwise, Vaca-Playdays is not responsible for refunding any participants who cancel after registrations have been received.

EARLY BIRD REGISTRATIONS:

Early bird registration and payment must be received by February 5 for the February Program and April 9 for the April program. Registrations will be accepted up until Friday, February 12 and April 16, respectively. Registration space is always subject to availability.
