We the undersigned respectfully submit the following Warrant Article for consideration at the 2009 Lincoln Town Meeting. This Warrant Article is supported by a petition signed by ten registered voters in Lincoln. We understand that to be valid the required number of voters must not only sign their names but also state their residence, with street and number.

We follow the form presented in An Outline of Town Meeting Procedures:
Typically the Article will be "to see if the Town will . . . [take some action]"

The Article is as follows:

To see if the Town will vote to

expand the size of the Lincoln Board of Selectmen from three members to five members, adding two members to be elected by vote during the regular town election in 2010;







