Master Plan

- *Speed limit reduction - police are working on*
- *Conceptual Design for 9 projects*
 - *Farrar / 126 crosswalk - waiting on cost estimation 5yr Transportation Coal. plan*
 - *117 Mt Misery path extension - talk to original path proponents. Perhaps consider moving crosswalk east to different trail entrance.*
 - *Weston Rd - HSI completed edge of pavement survey, producing conceptual design with very rough cost for plan that has some advisory shoulder, small amount of roadside path, some road widening.*

- *Tower Rd / 117 - on 5yr Transportation Coal. plan, consider mountable islands to narrow turning radius, consider abutter contact as next step.*
- *Trapelo crosswalks: Lexington Rd, Page Rd - HSI to sketch, on 5yr Transp. Coal. plan. Consider Lexington Rd as part of Trapelo drainage repaving 2025*
- *Bedford Rd crosswalk: HSI suggests town ask MassDOT, town occupied with speed limit reduction first. Need to bring this back up with new DPW Supt.*
- *Lincoln School bus fees, 7th/8th grade fees more than 2 miles from school eliminated FY26; engage with School Committee to reduce/eliminate within 2 miles of school*
- *Motorists give 4' to Pass signage - add pedestrian symbol and install on minor connectors, town to reach out to MassDOT, town occupied with speed limit reduction first*
- *Education*
 - *2nd grade pedestrian education with SRTS*
- *Incident Reports from Det. Spencer*
- *Potential Future Initiatives*
