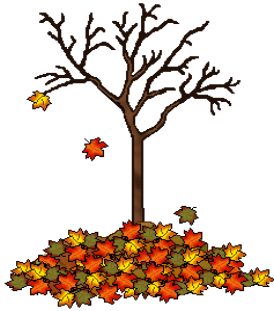


Tuesday Trail Walks
